

ADOBE ILLUSTRATOR: Vector Drawing – Easter Theme

Objective: After viewing this week’s video lectures, you will create your own version of a bunny and at least two Easter eggs. The main goal is to use the techniques mentioned in the videos. However, you may feel free to exercise your creativity and originality to embellish beyond the simple skills. For instance, it is okay to draw a rabbit on all fours or anyway you wish.

The illustration below is simply an example. The overriding criteria must be met, as listed below:

- Creating an **attractive bunny** with at least the amount of intricacy as the one in the videos.
- Creating **at least 2 good looking Easter eggs** while using **Shape Builder tool** as explained in the video.
